## Coaches and Managers

We are expecting a lot of bunnies at this year's Bunnyfest! At last count, 325! Add parents, siblings, grandparents, and everyone else, and it will be a cozy afternoon! To make the day go smoothly please observe the following:

### Game-related

- Teams must check in upon arrival at the registration desk in the lobby. Medals and snack coupons will be given to the coach or manager at that time.
- Bunnies should arrive at the arena dressed - dressing rooms will be shared by two teams at once and are only for tying skates and storing bags while on the ice.
- The dressing rooms will be colour coded the same as the teams on the schedule.
- Only one parent per bunny (or less) in the dressing rooms! Please --No siblings, strollers, etc., etc.
- Players must have proper Ringette equipment. Players with hockey masks, cut-off hockey sticks, etc. will not be allowed on the ice.
- Teams must be ready to get on the ice five minutes before their ice time.

### Off-ice related

- The activities upstairs will begin at 1:00
- There will be colouring, crafts, face painting, magic shows and snacks.
- Snacks- each bunny will be given a coupon for a hotdog, juice box, and cupcake; there will be additional hot dogs for sale for siblings for \$1.00, and juice boxes and cup cakes will be .25 each.
- Magic shows will be at 1:30, 3:00 and 4:30.
- Teams will be assigned tables, but teams will have to share as well!
- We hope to have an area upstairs where teams can assemble so you can take a team picture.
- Please tell the parents of your team to keep hallways clear and to put equipment bags not being used in the car.
